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

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#### **Introduction**

- During the last IEEE 1914 meetings we have been discussing the NGFI client side rates.
  - These rates are strongly dependent on the functional split between the antenna site and the controller side.
  - Unfortunately our work in this area depends on other SDOs to advance
- The line side rate of a NGFI compliant node seems to be less impacted by the actual split, since the assumption is that NGFI will use existent network technologies to carry the radio connections.
- Defining the required (or optional) line rates will enable other SDOs to verify their networking technology supports NGFI rates.



#### **Discussion**

- Two networking technologies that support electronic multiplexing are widely deployed: Ethernet and OTN
- Ethernet:
  - Standard nominal rates relevant to NGFI:
    - 1G
    - 10G
    - 25G
    - 100G
    - 400G
    - FlexE nx100G
  - Other rates being standardized:
    - 2.5G
    - 5G
    - 50G
  - Note that 2.5G and 5G are targeted for wifi hot spots connection to central units over existing copper. It does not seem it will become a networking interface.

#### **Discussion - continued**

- OTN:
  - Standard nominal rates relevant to NGFI:
    - OTU1 2.5G
    - OTU2 10G
    - OTU3 40G
    - OTU4 100G
    - OTUC4 400G
    - FlexO nx100G
  - OTU3 is not very popular
- Rates less than 10G seems to be to low to carry NGFI signals multiplexed with any other service.
- Rates higher than 100G seem to be an overkill for NGFI.
- The sweet spot: 10G 100G



# **Proposal**

  - 10G
  - 25G
  - 50G
  - 100G
- If agreed, forward the decision to the relevant SDOs.
