- Can OmH support use case of medical devices in ICU to analyze data in real time and raise early warnings?

- When will the API become part of the standard? / "I am not sure the API should not be part of the standard, if you look at HL7 FHIR they are only standardizing on resources, i.e., data formats"

- Are there links to HL7, FHIR, IHE and openEHR?
- Would it be feasible to separate standard to interface with devices to retrieve data and architecture for storing and processing data?
- Under Open mHealth, is there a standard procedure for the proposal, validation and approval of clinically valid schemas? Is it an interdisciplinary activity including consensus from medical doctors, statisticians, database designers, etc.?
