Introduced workstream and parallel processes needed to arrive at a draft document + schemas for NesCom (see slides 23 and 24). Process takes about a year and actual deadline for NesCom submission will be October 2027 to be included in December 2027 meeting agenda.

Update from CardioRespiratory subgroup (see slide 26, included in the main slide deck): the subgroup met on December 4

Aim to make time-series schemas generalizable to other use cases. Use movement domain as an example.

Physical activity measures are part of IEEE 1752.1 and not included in the current PAR. Proposal for amending the schema would need to go through the established process; it may not need a ballot, depending on the proposed changes.
