## Motion to disband inactive Working Groups (1)

- From time to time, we still received notification from myProject that an individual is interested in any of the C/SAB SC working groups that are no longer active.
- Currently, there are no rules or requirements on when a working group is disbanded or deactivated in myProject. However, there cannot be any formal working group actions without an SASB-authorized activity (e.g., a PAR). A working group is formed by a standards committee upon acceptance and assignment of a standards development project. Once there are no active standards development projects assigned, the standards committee may choose to take action to disband the working group or, based on coordination and discussion with the working group, choose to keep the working group active for potential future standards development projects or PAR study group activities.
