The IEEE Standards Board is changing the structure to organize Standards Coordinating Committees as Standards Committees. Due to this structural change, we will need to revise the SCC14 P&P document to reflect our new status as QUSCom.

7. Review of Draft 3 of the proposed QUSCom P&P

Draft 3 was reviewed and updated as needed, resulting in a new revision, Draft 4.

Of significant note:

- Scope is updates from SCC14 Scope as follows (requires two-thirds vote for approval):
 - From: <u>SCC14</u> studies questions regarding quantities, units, and systems of measurement; prepares recommendations and standards on these matters in support of the IEEE <u>Policy on metrics</u>; and provides current information on quantities and units to all organizations preparing IEEE standards in support of the IEEE SA Standards Board Implementation Plan for IEEE Policy 9.16. <u>The Committee</u> maintains the American National Standard for Metric Practice, IEEE/ASTM SI-10, and advises all IEEE entities on questions regarding metric practices and the application of the International System of Units (SI).
 - To: The Quantities, Units, and Symbols Standards Committee (QUSCom) studies questions regarding quantities, units, and systems of measurement; prepares recommendations and standards on these matters in support of the IEEE Metric Policy; and provides current information on quantities and units to all organizations preparing IEEE standards in support of the IEEE SA Standards Board Implementation Plan for IEEE Policy 9.16.
 QUSCom maintains the American National Standard for Metric Practice, IEEE/ASTM SI-10, and advises all IEEE entities on questions regarding metric practices and the application of the International System of Units (SI).
- The Selection of Officers was revised from "Election and Appointment of Officers" to "Appointment of Officers."
- Clarification of the process (clause 4.5) for revoking membership in cases of violation of the Code of Conduct requirements in Clause 1.1.

Also, during the review of the membership requirements, the Committee communicated a desire to make sure that the Committee continue to meet at least twice per year.
