7. Discussion Topics & Updates

<u>IEEE-SA Open-Source Policy</u>: Josh Gay gave a presentation on open-source options in IEEE standards. P1451.99 is moving to open source, and it is an option for future sensor standards. A copy of his slides is attached.

<u>SC-SC Membership Criteria</u>: An open discussion was undertaken about the current criteria for SC-SC Membership status. Current rules require SC-SC members to a member of IEEE-SA, and a member of at least one of the 26 Member Technical Societies of the Sensors Council. IEEE-staff pointed out that those requirements are not IEEE-SA policy so they can be relaxed by changing our approved SC-SC Policies and Procedures. For our next meeting, a draft of these changes will be discussed. The SC-SC can endorse a specific set of changes to take place in 2024 and submit for SC AdCom approval at its upcoming November 2023 meeting.
